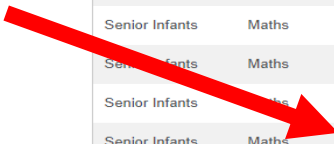





Word Study/Dictation – The children will study (read and write) their new sound (Long a) for the week. Give this list to them on Monday (cut out the words and sort them in to the 2 groups.)

They will do this again on Tuesday and then write them in to 2 lists.

On Wednesday they will rainbow write the 2nd list (rainbow writing, involves picking 3 colours and writing the words).

On Thursday they will pick a minimum of 3 words and write 3 sentences using this word.

On Friday – you will call out the 2nd list to the children (1 at a time) and allow them time to write the word. Then you will call out 2-3 sentences for them and they must write the sentence without your help.
