

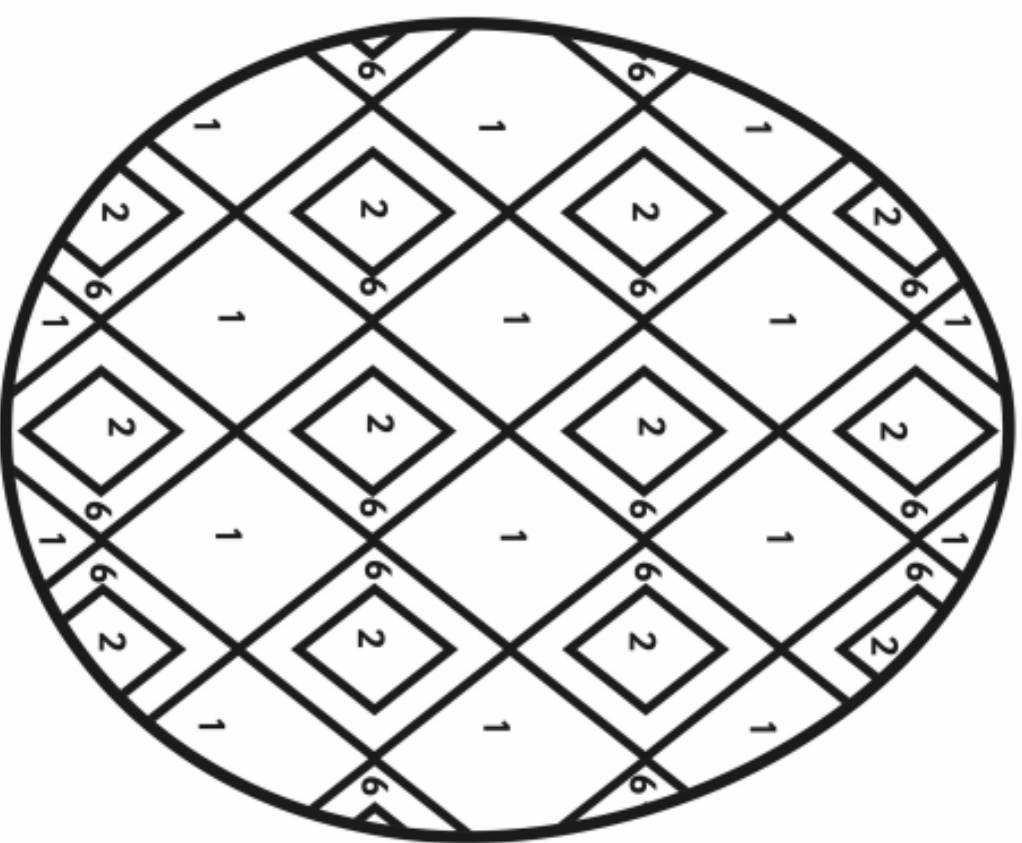

- 5 hours. Even though there aren't 50 eggs, the fifth hour is needed.
- No. They would need 5 boxes
- P-P-P, G-G-G, W-W-W, P-P-G, P-P-W, G-G-P, G-G-W, W-W-G, W-W-P, P-G-W, P-W-G, W-G-P, W-P-G, G-W-P, G-P-W, P-G-P, P-W-P, W-G-W, W-P-W, G-P-G, G-W-G
- A) 3 coins, 50p + 20p + 5p b) 75 x 1p
- A) Yes, house = odd, time = even, B) No, house = odd, time = odd

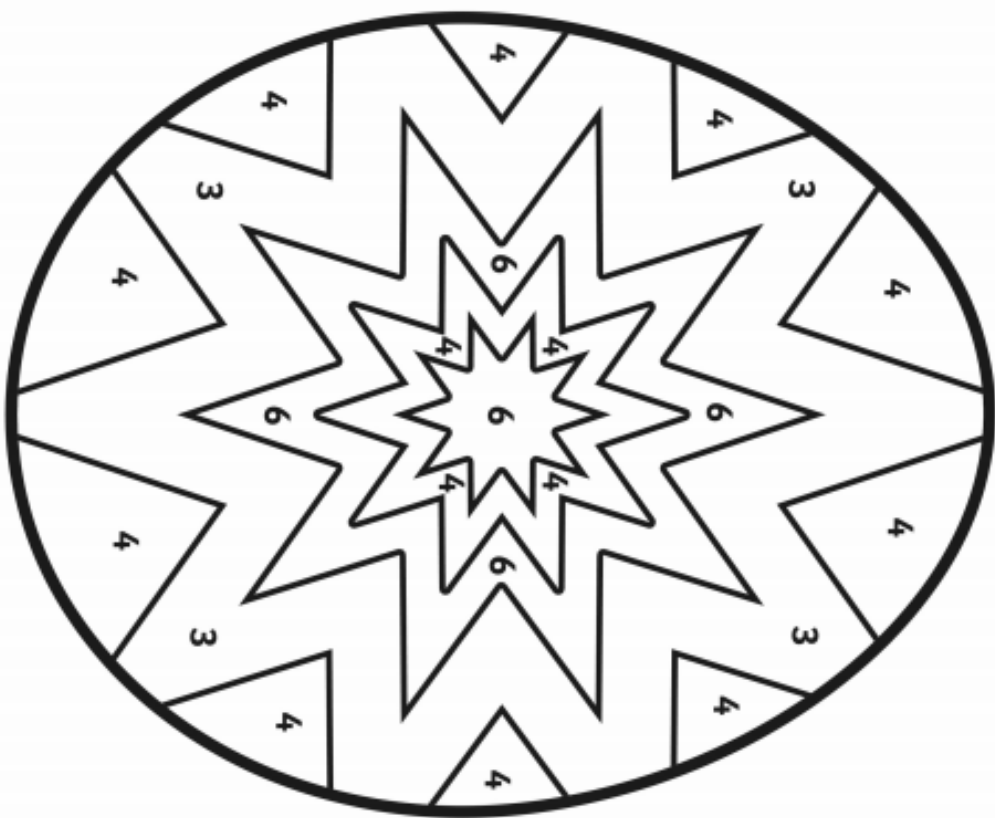

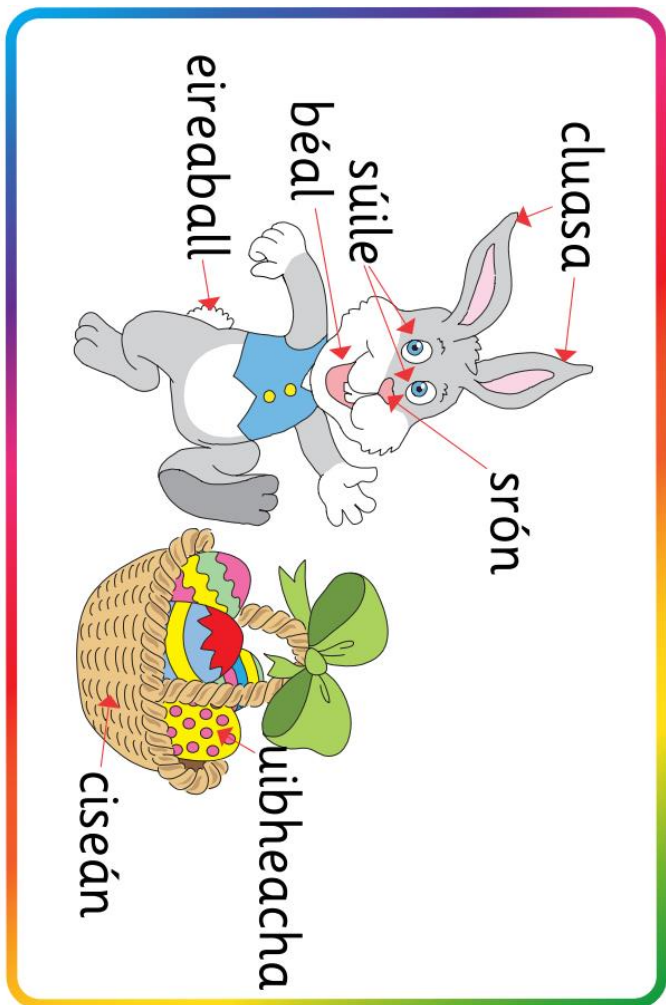
