<u>Keep a Diary</u> or encourage your child to <u>Free write</u> for approx. 15 minutes twice a week. It doesn't matter what they write as long as they are writing eg. Lists of favourite games, make up a poem or song etc.

<u>Make sums with these answers</u> We had done this in class before closure. Get your child to make as many $+ -(x \div)$ sums as they can, but they have to have the answer for that day. On Monday all your sums have to have the answer 12. Eg. 4+8=12, 6+6=12, 18-6=12, 24-12=12 (6x2=12, 4x3=12, 5x2+2=12, $24\div2=12$) etc. (brackets for 3^{rd} class)










Counties of Leinster




