## Monday

### Maths – Numbers

- Revision of number formation 1-10.
- Introduce writing the numbers 11-15. The kids should these easier to form as they will know the formation of the initial numbers. Show them the number and the word to match each number. (example 11 – eleven, 12 – twelve etc)
- Activity sheet – numbers 11-15 (see below)
  
- **Gaeilge** (word of the day) – scamall (cloud)

## Tuesday

### English - Phonics/Diagraphs

- Revise the jolly phonics sounds (most of our diagraph sounds from this year, start at approx 8 minutes) <https://vimeo.com/106231366>.
- Sound of the week – ue. Name words that have this sound in it (glue, blue tissue, statue etc). Ask them to write some of these words, using different colours for the ‘ue’ sound.. Find this sound in books and spell different words with it.
- Video to help with “ue” sound. (Padlet 2 Monday and Tuesday)
- ‘ue’ sound Activity Sheet (below)
  
- **Gaeilge** (word of the day) – buicéad (bucket)

## Wednesday

### Maths – Addition with the Number 10

- Revise all number formations to 10. (Write the numbers to 10.
- Maths Activity Sheet (below) – Revision of addition skills up to 10. Use counters and fingers if needed.

## Thursday

### English Letter Formation and Reading

- Practice writing the capital Q and small q on a page, copy, in sand or on a whiteboard.

- Activity sheet – handwriting – capital Q (see below).
- Revise letter formation online – (See Padlet 4 Thursday). This is a great way to practice the formation of Q and it can be used on the iPad.

##### Mental Maths – Friday

- Friday will be ‘Mental Maths’ day. This will include activities to help them revise and consolidate all the concepts and topics studied in Junior and Senior Infants.

It is aimed towards first class, so your child will need assistance at first to understand that they must read the question and present the answer. The child is not expected to be able read the questions, but they can have a go at it, with your help. They will eventually become more comfortable with reading the questions and the layout.

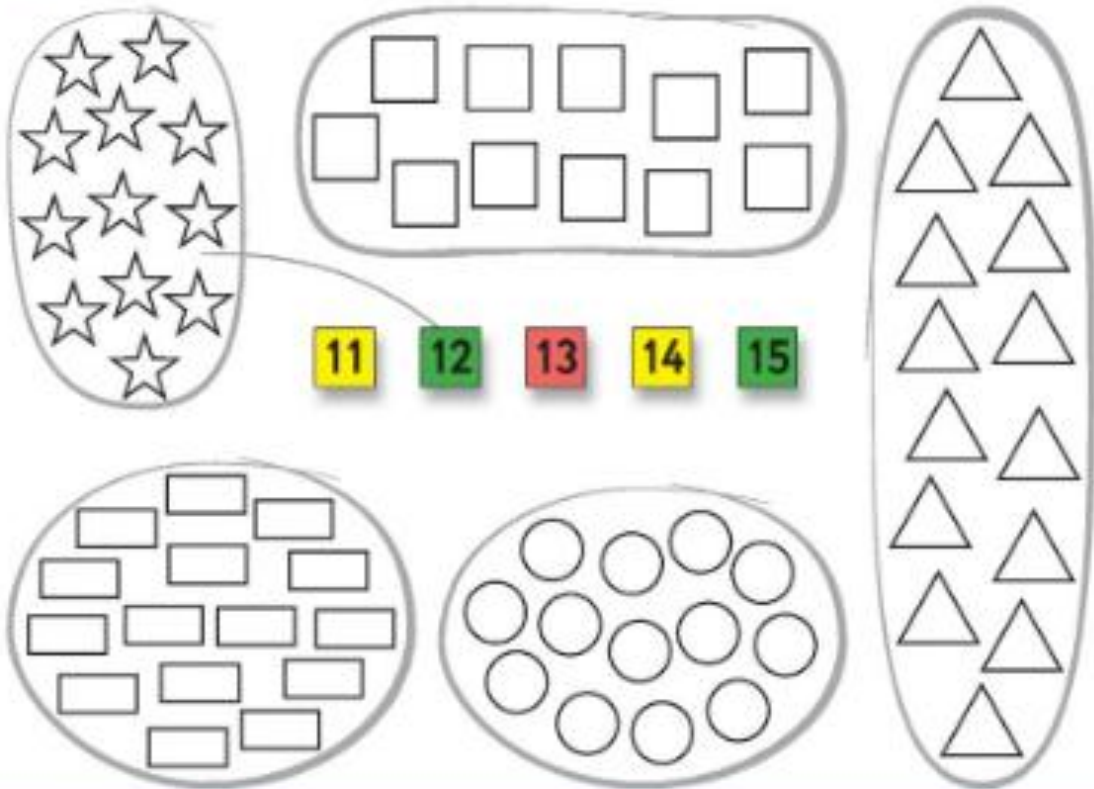

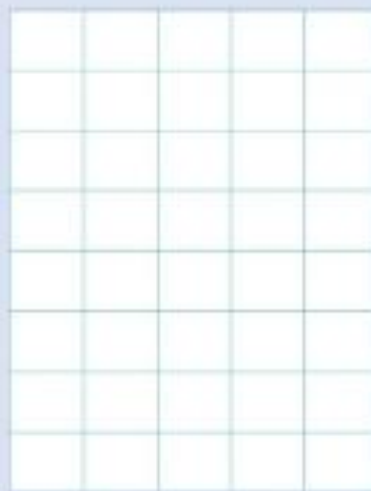

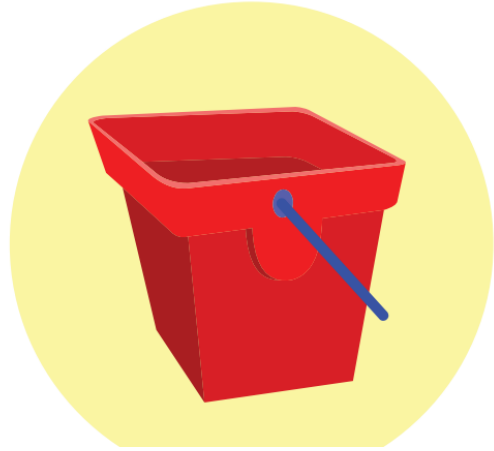
